According to Hayes, the credit union began operations in the summer of 1979, with a federal charter. Within six months, it had about 800 members, with assets reaching \$170,000. "As with any new corporation, we struggled for a while with regulatory and operational issues," Hayes admits. "Over the course of four decades, Loyola Credit Union has grown to 5,000-plus members, with assets exceeding \$48 million.

"From our fledgling beginnings, we have evolved into a strong and well respected full-service financial institution; one that is recognized by its members as being there for them. We have been there for 40 years, and we plan to be here for at least the next 40 years."
